Leo High School Participates In Commemorative Tribute August 26, 2007

On November 27th 1937, Leo Lions played Austin of the Public league in one of the most historic football games ever played. Prolific running backs, John Galvin of Leo and Bill DeCorrvant of Austin, plus talented teammates drew 120,000 fans to Soldier Field. This is the largest crowd ever to attend a football game.

On August 26th 2007, at the Kick Off Classic at Soldier Field, the Public and Catholic leagues commemorated that game. John Daley, Leo's quarterback that day in 1937, also believed to be the last living member of that team, and Leo student Willie Butler, Class of 2009, represented Leo at the ceremony. John Daley and a former Austin Team member, Phil Bouzeos conducted the coin toss before the Hubbard-Fenwick game. Mr. Daley was also presented with a jersey and commemorative plaque by President Rich Furlong immediately following the ceremony. John Daley was most appreciative and asked Rich to express his appreciation to all Leo Alumni for according him that honor.

Tim Foley '72 a standout football and basketball player at Leo was recently elected by a landslide to lead the International Brotherhood of Electrical Workers Local 134. He has worked as an electrician, a foreman and business agent during his 34-year career

Jim '44 and Loretta Coogan celebrated their 55th wedding anniversary on June 21st.

Ed Ryan '57 was inducted into the Chicago Catholic League Hall of Fame. Ed is a Leo legend who in his senior year led Leo to the City Championship and was named to the All Catholic, All City, All State and High School All American Teams. Ed continued his football career at Michigan State University. He earned all Big Ten honors and was named captain of the 1961 Blue - Grey All Star Game, captain of the North Team in the Senior Bowl and co - captain of the East Squad in the 1962 All - American game. Ed distinguished himself in the classroom as well by earning All - American Academic Honors in 1961. Ed continued his career in Canada, playing with both the Toronto Argonauts and Ottawa Rough Riders.

Tom O'Malley '57 has been inducted into the 16 inch Softball Hall of Fame. Tom was a basketball player at Leo. He then went to Loras College where he graduated. He has excelled in the coaching profession. He has coached basketball at Leo, where he won the Catholic Championship in 1973, Reavis and Evergreen Park. He has been coaching at St Xavier's University for the last 10 years where has won over 250 games.

Terrence L. Bates '86 purchased at an auction a 1942 Prep Bowl Medallion given to the winner of the Prep Bowl. Leo defeated Tilden 27 - 14 at Soldier Field. It belonged to a Leo player, sophomore half back, N. Duphanes. It is made of solid gold with a diamond at the top and fully engraved with the original presentation box. Terrence said a number of other people were bidding on it but Terrence felt it was his obligation as a Leo man to secure it. Facta non verba Terrence!.

This girls high school known as St. Leo High School continued in that capacity until Mercy High School at 8100 S. Prairie was established in 1924.

So for 9 years there was a St. Leo High School, a girls school. So there you have the rest of the story.

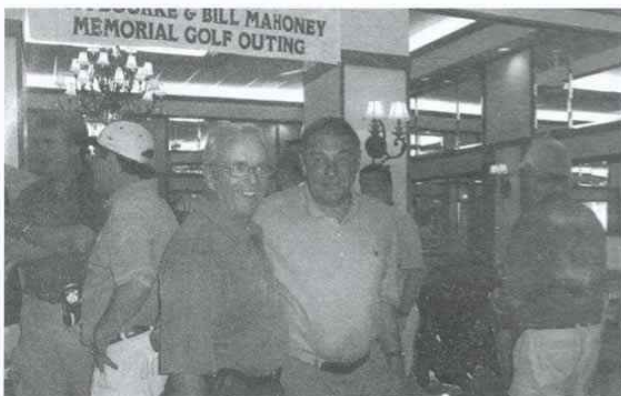
