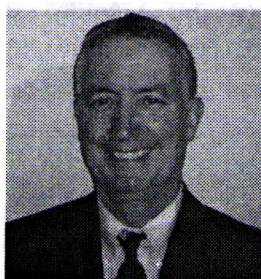

From the President

I ran into some guys from other parishes and we are still friends to this day. I couldn't wait to get home and tell my parents how the test went. How big the school was and how I couldn't wait to go to high school. My brother went to Tilden, so I was lucky to be going to a Catholic high school. When I got home, my uncle was sitting at the kitchen table. Not all that unusual, but my mom and dad were not home. He proceeded to tell me that my father died that morning and my mom was making arrangements for him. You can imagine the tailspin your life takes in an instant. I learned two

very important lessons that day, although I wouldn't know it until years later. My mother never wavered in my quest to go to Leo. We didn't have a lot of money, but she said, "We will figure it out." The second is how welcoming Leo and the archdiocese were in helping me go to Leo. If it wasn't for their generosity, I would not have been able to go. They BOTH felt that a young man should have the structure in his life to be successful. The reason that I am sharing this with you is that there are hundreds of young men out there who are part of single family homes and some that really have no home at all. In order for them to get a good, quality Catholic education, they need assistance. Assistance can be in many forms, so if you can help out, I am sure that Dan McGrath and Phil Mesina would welcome it.

This is an election year, and the membership has some very deserving individuals that will take the organization to the next level. If you would like to get involved, please contact me or any of the other officers or better yet, come to a meeting. (Check the web for dates and times)

In my two years as President, we have made some great strides in the organization.
